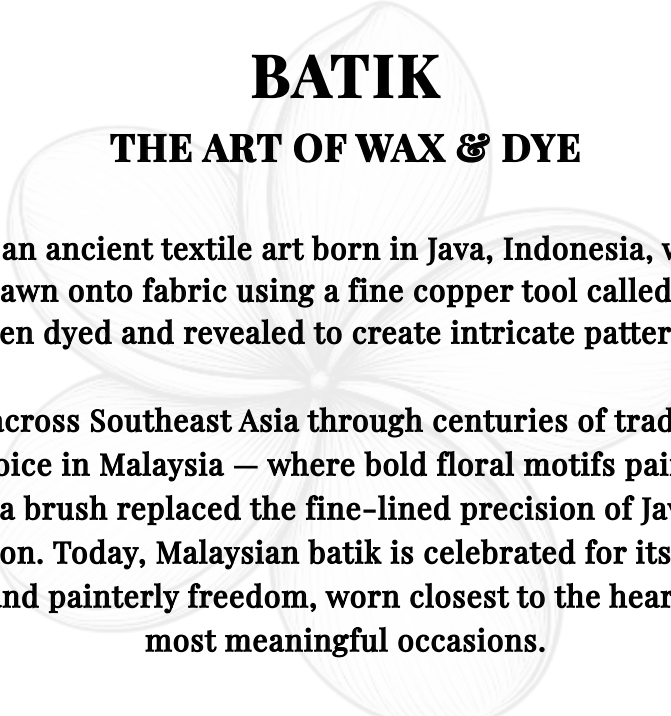






BATIK

THE ART OF WAX & DYE

Batik is an ancient textile art born in Java, Indonesia, where hot wax is drawn onto fabric using a fine copper tool called a canting, then dyed and revealed to create intricate patterns.

Carried across Southeast Asia through centuries of trade, it found its own voice in Malaysia — where bold floral motifs painted freely with a brush replaced the fine-lined precision of Javanese tradition. Today, Malaysian batik is celebrated for its vibrant colour and painterly freedom, worn closest to the heart on life's most meaningful occasions.
